

Final reminders for performances

- Please use the north side accessible entrance facing the parkway next to the digital billboard
- Dressing rooms will be posted in the main lobby
- Students will be asked to stand next to the poster with their song name until a volunteer can take them to their dressing rooms
- Please pack a small snack and water for your child. Do not pack snacks that will stain costumes. Don't forget we have various allergies including all nuts and eggs.
- Do not pack markers as this will stain costumes
- Please do not add any extra jewelry or head pieces that are not part of the costume.
- Please arrive fully dressed
- Make sure all personal belongings are labeled in case they are misplaced. This includes costumes, shoes and tights.
- Only scheduled volunteers are permitted backstage
- Please pack quiet games and items to entertain the children while backstage

Arrival time on performance night is 5:15pm

We will need to get students settled in their dressing rooms prior to the call for the show. Memories Forever will be on site to capture the backstage moments. If you are late you may miss the taping.

Our show will be approximately 2 hours in length. There will be no intermission.

Dismissal Procedure

Please review our dismissal procedures posted on our website under important info. *This is different than previous years and very important*

For students in multiple dances, they will exit the theatre with the last group they danced with. This is the level where caregivers can find them.

Quick Change

If your dancer is in multiple classes, please review the info on our website to make sure they are on the quick change list. For our younger students, a routine is considered quick change if there are 10 numbers between. For older students, a quick change would be 6 dances or less. They will need to bring their costumes/shoes/tights backstage to dressing room #4 before the recital. Please make sure everything is labeled.
